CONTEST RULES

Categories:

- 1) Wildlife and plant life
- 2) Landscapes
- 3) Events and Activities ** (** need to complete consent form for photos with people)

Eligible persons:

The contest is open to all amateur photographers residing on the North Shore.

Eligible photographs:

Submitted photographs must have been taken within the limits of the North Shore (spanning from Tadoussac to Havre Saint-Pierre and including Fermont and Schefferville). The date must not appear on the photo. Black and white pictures will not be accepted. Photos can be any year and any season.

Copyright:

Each entrant grants us the right to reproduce publish and display all photographs submitted for promotional and print purposes. The photographs must be free of rights and the participant certifies that he /she is the author.

Submission of photographs

Participants can submit a maximum of 1 photograph per category which must be on digital support, in JPEG form with a minimum resolution of 300 DPI and deposited either:

- By deposit at the head office of the North Shore Community Association at the following address: 39 Marquette Baie-Comeau, Local 314, GRZ 1K4

The pictures must also be accompanied by the following information:

- The name of the photographer;
- The title of the picture;
- The complete address and phone number;
- The area where the picture was taken;
- Completed consent form for pictures with people.

Deadline:

All pictures must have been received by September 15,2017 at the latest.

Selection of winners:

A jury will select the best pictures for each one of the categories. In addition, a Grand Prize will be awarded for the best picture among all those submitted. All decisions will be made by majority vote and will be without appeal. The three selection criteria will be: respect for the category, the originality of the picture, the quality of the picture.

In the case where no picture has been submitted in a category, a jury prize will then be awarded to a photograph that has not been retained in another category.

The prizes:

The winners in <u>each category</u> will receive a prize worth **\$100.00**. The winners will be revealed during the Annual General Meeting on Saturday, September 23, 2017. All participants will be invited to attend.

The winning pictures will be published on the website of the North Shore Community Association.
