The completed application form must be submitted to the NSCA by mail or by email on or before **June 17, 2022**.

You are graduating from high school this year and will be enrolled full time at an accredited post-secondary educational institution this fall.

Are you an outstanding community volunteer?

Do you continually commit your time, talent, and energy, without receiving payment, to improve and serve your community?

Have you provided extraordinary help or care to families or groups in your community through your unpaid volunteer contributions?

Have you been voluntarily involved in a program or project that has had lasting benefits for the community and community members?

Will you be pursuing full-time studies at a recognized post-secondary educational institution?
