Leadership and Engagement

A Youth Director shall be chosen from each of the two territories along the North Shore:

- Eastern Territory (representing Baie Trinité to Havre Saint Pierre, including Fermont and Schefferville)
- Western territory (representing Godbout to Tadoussac)

Youth Directors must:

- Be between sixteen (16) and twenty-nine (29) years of age.
- Be chosen by the Board of Directors.
- Reside in one of the two above territories along the North Shore.


